Jesus has never failed on His promise to always be there for us. Part of His plan is to demonstrate His presence and blessing through His children, whom He sends out to serve the hurting and poor. Reach & Rescue Ministries, Inc. has the privilege of being a part of His plan.

Reach & Rescue Ministries visits six sites across three counties in Northeast Ohio. Our organization is 501c3 non-profit, established in 2012. We are made up of three teams:

- Service regular visits to provide Bible studies, comfort, and special programs to residents of shelters and low-income housing.
- 2) Transition collection and distribution of small furniture, clothing, household items and personal care items to families moving from shelters to housing.
- 3) Follow-up communication with formerly homeless families to connect them with churches, support groups, and public agencies.

The Transition Program – Getting Them Home
The move into a new home is stressful for any
family. Imagine moving from homelessness,
children and all, and with no possessions to take
with you. What a challenge. Our Transition Team
is available to help take the pressure off families
during this stage. And you can help.

Donors can contact Reach & Rescue at 216-470-4293 to arrange for a pick-up or delivery of items. A representative with call back to confirm the details.

At the exchange a tax-deductible receipt will be issued to the donor, who may deduct the fair market value of the contribution on their federal taxes.

Some suggested contributions would include

Small appliances – toasters, microwaves, can openers, televisions, vacuum cleaners, computers, coffee pots, air fryers, etc.

Household items – lamps, rugs, dishes, pots/pans, flatware, pillows, towels, bedding, blankets, brooms, mops, cleaning supplies, decorations, trash cans, etc.

Personal items – clothing, shoes, purses, jewelry, grooming supplies, razors, toothpaste, deodorant, combs, brushes, lotions, feminine products, diapers and baby needs, etc.

Financial donations – transportation, storage, office materials, supplies, etc.
