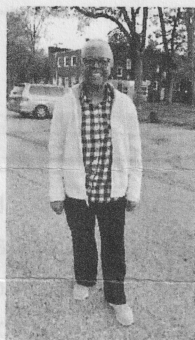


Above and Beyond
