What We Do and How We Do it

Reach & Rescue Ministries, Inc. has been involved in improving the lives of women, men and families for over two decades. Through the **Service Team** we teach, lead Bible studies and chapels, sing, dance, provide residents opportunities to become sons and daughters of God, and encourage fellowship and success, across three counties in Northeast Ohio.

The **Transition Team** is responsible for collecting and distributing gently used clothing and shoes, small appliances, linens, dishes, pots and pans, utensils, glassware, lamps, cleaning supplies, new personal items, and, of course, Bibles. We make appointments to transfer items from our donors to the families in need.

A critical part of the ministry is added to reinforce the Gospel message and insure growth and victory in the former residents of shelters. The members of the **Follow-up Team** commit to six months of communication with the formerly homeless families. They find out information such as where the family attends church, how their children are doing in school, and where they can find social agencies they may need.
